

**Request Period for Land Farmers and Livestock Breeders under Malta's Common
Agricultural Policy Strategic Plan 2023-2027: Registration of new Agricultural Land
and Aid Applications**

The Agriculture and Rural Payments Agency (ARPA), within the Ministry for Agriculture, Fisheries and Food Supply (MAFF), is accepting applications from those farmers who wish to carry out:

- Transfers and land registration for inclusion into land-based aid schemes;
- Changes in land use of those areas currently not eligible for funds to now be included as eligible;
- Land registration for Eco-Schemes;
- Land registration for Environmental, Climate-related and other Management Commitments (AECCs) under the CAP Strategic Plan 2023-2027
 - Requests for new commitments will only be accepted under AECC 7a, and 7b.
 - Requests for new commitments under AECC1a, 1b, 1c, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 will not be accepted

For such requests, farmers must present the following documents:

- ID card;
- Site plans of fields;
- In case the person making the request is doing so on behalf of a third party, a power of attorney document provided by a notary is required, along with the ID of the representative;
- Will (in case of transfer by inheritance).

Requests will be received from the **6th of July 2026 to September 18th 2026** in the following offices

- **Front Office ARPA:** Pitkali Markets, Ta' Qali, Limits of Attard, from Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 11:30am; or
- **Front Office ARPA, Gozo:** Da Paola, Level 1, Fortunato Mizzi Street, Victoria, from Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 11:30am.
